Stunning Photographic Reproduction on Glass with DecoTherm

- Ø Know the primary viewing direction of the finished piece. Photography depends on highlight areas and shadow areas to make the image look correct.

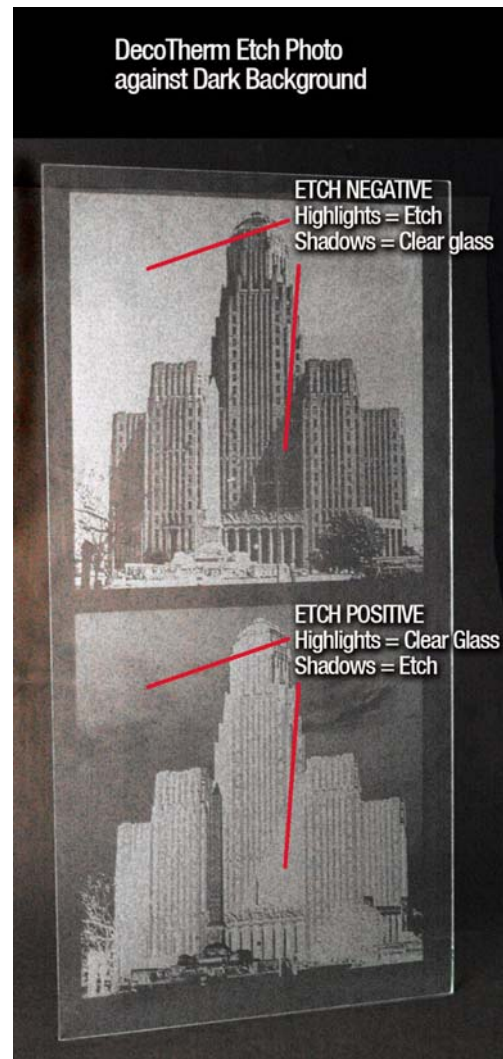
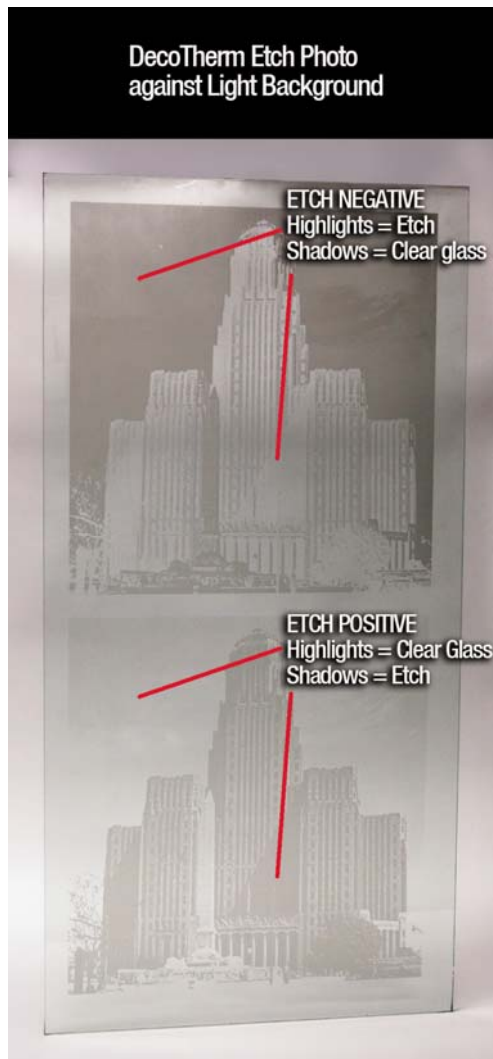
	Light Background	Dark Background
Light Colored Frit	Not Recommended	Color = highlight Clear glass = shadow
Dark Colored Frit	Color = shadow Clear glass = highlight	Not Recommended

- Ø Begin design with high resolution photos
- Ø Photos must be in black and white and should have excellent contrast with a complete tonal range from 100% black to white.
- Ø Color correct the photos to ensure that the darkest shadow areas have some 100% black and the lightest areas are 0% or white.
- Ø It is best to view a sample at the desired location and determine the proper output.
